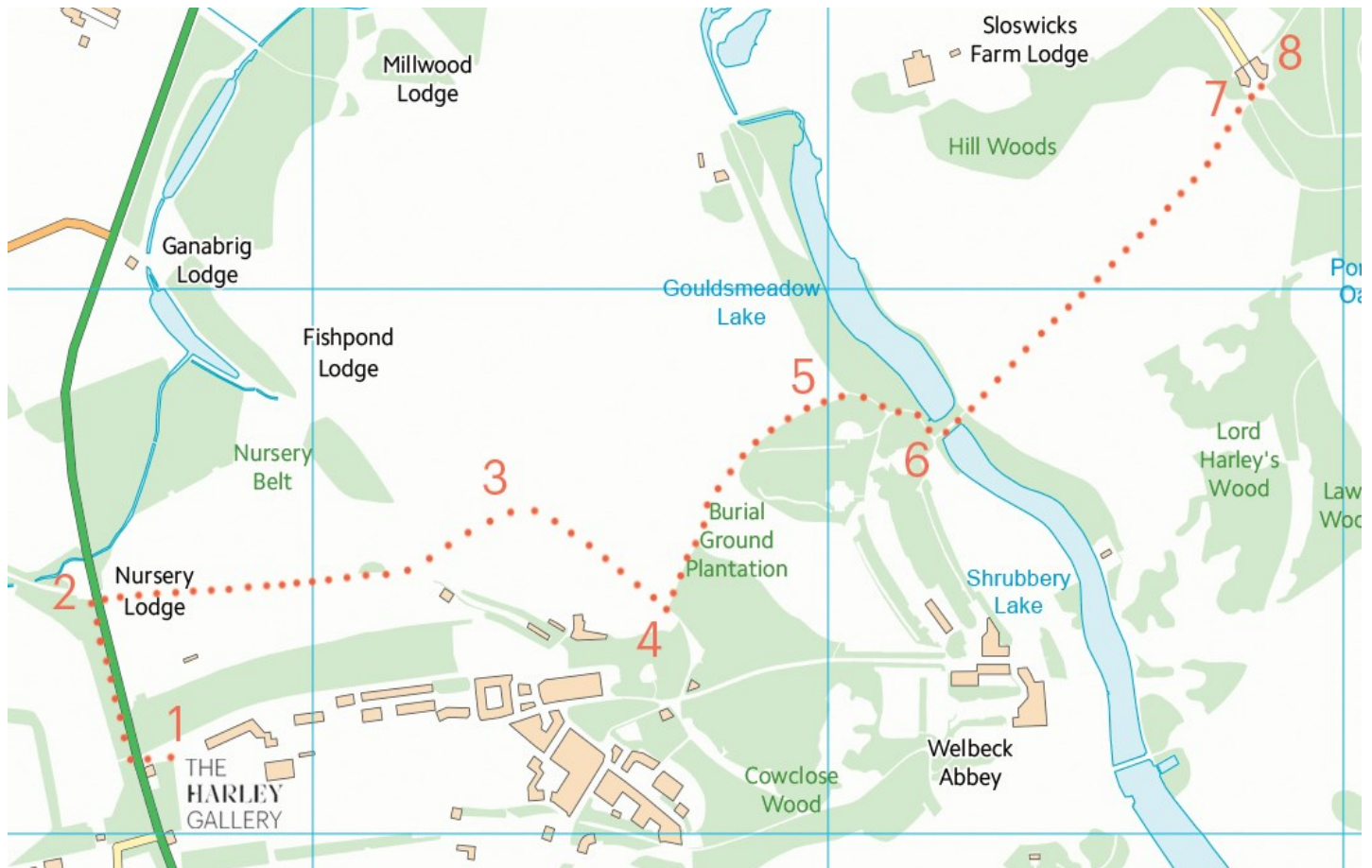


SOUTH TUNNEL LODGE

This walk follows the Robin Hood Way from The Harley Gallery and through the Welbeck Estate to end at South Tunnel Lodge, for a distance of 2.1 (3.8 km) miles each way. The Lodge sits at the entrance to one of the Welbeck Estate tunnels, built by the 5th Duke of Portland in the late 1800's.

From South Tunnel Lodge, additional footpaths are available to Clumber Park and Worksop if you wish to continue your walk. Otherwise, please retrace your steps back to The Harley Gallery car park.

The walk includes a range of walking surfaces, with some slight inclines. The footpath adjacent to the A60 is a narrow paved footpath suitable for single file pedestrians. This walk also includes broad, concrete paths and unpaved, uneven stretches.

Café and toilet facilities are available at The Harley Gallery.

1. Start

The Harley Gallery car park
(GPS 53.261234,-1.179231)

Walk from the car park to the main road (A60).

2. Cross over the road to the footpath and turn right until you reach 'Nursery Lodge' on the left hand side.

(GPS 53.264144,-1.183316)

3. At the house, just past the bus stop, cross over the road to the footpath to your right. Continue down this tree lined footpath, past a house on your right, and over the field to the crossroads.

(GPS 53.26511,-1.170013)

4. Cross straight over and continue up the path over the field, toward the woodland.

Just before you reach the wood, turn left to follow the marker for the Robin Hood Way.

(GPS 53.263743,-1.166484)

5. Follow the path along for 0.4 miles (600 meters), skirting a woodland, open field and a further woodland, to a private road.

(GPS 53.267395,-1.16128)

6. Turn right onto the road

and follow the marker for the Robin Hood Way. Continue to follow the road, veering to the left to cross between the two lakes.

(GPS 53.26699,-1.157986)

Follow the footpath straight across the field, for 0.5 miles (1km).

7. Walk through the two gates, marked for the Robin Hood Way.

8. End
